Summary: Vaillant sells Pez's *Sonate* Op. 2, Marini's *Sonate* Op. 6, Corelli's *Sonates* set for the recorder, Novell's *Sonate* Op. 1, Keller's *Sonates* Op. post., Albicastro's *Sonate* Op. 9, Gentili's *Sonate* Op. 3 and D'Anglebert's *Pieces de clavecin*. Soon will be available the new edition of Corelli's *Sonate* Opp. 1-4.
